



This series is offered in partnership with the Antioch Unified School District. It is appropriate for ALL caregivers and professionals who work with children in Contra Costa County.

- > Teach and coach your child by first understanding the Life-Space; brain structure/function, developmental pathways
- > Identify and teach/coach your child's temperament and "protest style"
- > "See" and assess your child's current skills and develop a parenting response that leads to maturation in self-soothing, emotion management, self-regulation and conscience-driven behavior
- > Use limits/boundaries and strategic consequences to help your child "accept and surrender" to parent/teacher directions and the rules and laws that keep us safe
