Camilla's leadership has also been instrumental in the development of the Economic Opportunity Council, supporting the distribution of funding to community agencies through the Community Services Block Grant. Most recently, Camilla has been one of the community leaders creating healthy and safe child care services for Covid-19 first responders in our county.
