Tomorrow, EHSD will again partially open four of our district offices as places for Contra Costa residents to cool off during the extreme heat. Please pass this information along to any customers who may need relief from the high temperatures we are experiencing. These locations are open from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Wednesday, June 3rd. Water and charging stations available.

Places to COOL OFF During Extreme Heat

To cool off on days of extreme heat, Employment & Human Services Department (EHSD) has the below locations open. Please note that during the COVID-19 shelter in place, EHSD's regular programs and services are currently NOT available at these offices.
