Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) - Up to 12 weeks FMLA at 2/3 pay for companies with <500 workers																								
Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) - Provides food benefits to help families with children who are eligible for free or reduced-price school meals. On 1/22/2021, USDA announced that Pandemic EBT benefits will be increased by approximately 15% in support of Presidential Executive Order																								
Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) - Raises each household's regular monthly CalFresh allotment to maximum allowable amount (extended on a monthly basis)																								
Stimulus Checks - Up to \$1,200 per eligible adult (maximum 2 per household) and \$500 per child up to age 17 in household																								
Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (PUC) - \$600 supplement to individuals receiving Unemployment Benefits (regular or PUA)																								
Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) - Unemployment Benefits for Self-Employed/Gig Workers																								
Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC) - Extended benefits for people who have exhausted state's time limit (e.g., 26 weeks)																								
Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) - Small business loan program																								
Student Loan Payment Pause - CARES Act																								
Executive Action to Establish a Statewide Moratorium on Evictions - Governor Newsom																								
Contra Costa County Residential Eviction Moratoria - County Board of Supervisors																								
Lost Wages Assistance (LWA) Program - Authorized by Presidential Memorandum; provides an additional \$300 per week for up to six weeks to eligible applicants																								
California AB 3088 - State eviction moratorium. California SB91 - AB3088 <u>tenant</u> protections extended to 6/30/2021; <u>property owner and landlord</u> protections extended to 9/1/2021																								
U.S. Centers for Disease Control (CDC) Eviction Protections Order																								
Contra Costa County Commercial Eviction Moratorium for certain small business/commercial tenants - County Board of Supervisors																								
CRRSA CalFresh (SNAP) Benefits Increase - 15% increase in maximum monthly benefit amount																								
CRRSA Rental Assistance - Federal Rental Assistance \$31 million allocated to Contra Costa County, and \$37 million state share (\$68 million total available for rent assistance). California SB 91 (signed 1/29/21) outlines process by which the rental assistance funds will be applied; first priority is to rental arrears for tenants and landlords. Funds generally expire on 12/31/2021; at least 65% of the funds must be obligated by 9/30/21.
