Unfortunately, the area surrounding Las Deltas, including previous housing, had demolished, leaving the area desolate and lacking community traffic, making staff and families feel isolate uneasy upon arrival and departure and during the hours of operation. All Las Deltas teaching and site staff continue to work in the capacity they are currently working. No jobs will be lost or eliminated during the r to Crescent Park. Additionally, children currently enrolled at Las Deltas who remain age-eligible will contin receiving preschool, toddler, and/or infant services at the Crescent Park location. Families who choose no the Crescent Park center will be given priority placement at the nearby locations of Verde, Contra Costa Co YMCA CDC, or YMCA 8th Street.
