Poll Worker Program for County Employees September 14, 2021 Gubernatorial Recall Election

Help make democracy happen on September 14th! This is your chance to play an important part in the voting process in Contra Costa. <u>We are particularly looking for individuals willing to serve as lead poll workers in Antioch, Bethel Island, Knightsen, Oakley, and Richmond.</u>

As a poll worker, you will draw your regular County pay, plus receive a stipend of \$125. Lead poll workers will receive \$230. Bilingual individuals are highly encouraged to participate.

To participate, you must:

- Be a <u>permanent</u> Contra Costa County employee.
- Be a registered voter in any California county or a legal permanent resident who would otherwise be eligible to vote.
- Be available to work from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. anywhere in the County.
- Attend a 1-hour online training class and a 30-minute in-person training class.
- Receive approval from your Department Head or their designee.
- Wear a mask and abide by all COVID protocols when attending training and serving on Election Day.
