# How your Dollars make a Difference

- \$1 per pay period** can provide medical teaching dolls to help explain a diagnosis to children.
- \$1 per pay period** enables a struggling family to be connected to a food pantry and another vital service like utility bill assistance – 24 hours a day.
- \$1 per pay period** could provide on the spot emergency assistance to 2 fire victims
- \$2 per pay period** provides free tax preparation for one family, ensuring they get the refunds owed to them to help meet basic needs.
- \$2 per pay period** can aid in the training of therapy animals for the disabled and seniors.
- \$5 per pay period** covers the cost of growing 45 native plants for the Redwood Creek Watershed.
- \$5 per pay period** could provide 25 meals for a homeless child for a month.

- \$15 per pay period** provides 4 relief beds for refugees with nowhere to sleep.
- \$15 per pay period** will help pay for a free 24/7 Alzheimer’s Helpline staffed by master’s-level clinicians and specialists.
- \$20 per pay period** allows 10 students to experience San Francisco Bay in a four-hour science-based outdoor education field trip.
- \$20 per pay period** could provide a homebound AIDS patient with groceries for a full year.
- \$20 per pay period** pays for specialized summer recreational programming for 112 children.
- \$100** could provide an abused child a caring foster home for a month, or vaccines to small villages abroad.

## FAQ

**WHY GIVE THROUGH YOUR CAMPAIGN?** This is the most efficient way to give. All donations are centrally processed and distributed directly to your charity of choice. Donors can give more because the donation is spread over the year. Charities benefit because payroll deduction ensures a consistent and reliable stream of income throughout the year.

**WHY DONATE THROUGH A FEDERATION?** Federations provide an important service to non-profit organizations. They screen charities for the highest public accountability and standards. By combining services under a federation umbrella, charities consolidate their marketing, fundraising and processing expenses, and reduce their costs.

**WHY ARE THERE ADMINISTRATIVE FEES?** Federations, like all nonprofits, in order to function must cover basic operating expenses, which are kept to a minimum, so the majority of donations to go to their charities programs. Federations are regulated and must register with the State Attorney General, file annual IRS Form 990, and receive annual independent audit. Federations and their member charities are approved by your employer for inclusion in your workplace giving campaign.

**WHY GIVE THROUGH PAYROLL DEDUCTION?** Workplace campaigns are a very efficient form of non-profit fundraising. They are a proven cost-effective alternative to direct mail, telemarketing, annual fundraising drives and special event marketing.
