REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP) #1188 Differential Response Path II and After Care Services

Questions & Answers

All questions regarding RFP 1188 are shown as submitted in writing by the RFP Questions due to EHSD date.

PROGRAM

1. If applying for all three (3) service areas, are bidders required to submit 3 separate proposals?

Per page 17 of RFP 1188, "Bidders may bid for more than one region, however, must submit individual proposals for each region."

2. Does the county have any preference for 3 different agencies vs one or two?

Per page 4 of RFP 1188, "CFS is interested in having one (1) agency provide DR services in one of each of the three Contra Costa County regions: East, West, and Central County." By adhering to the three (3) stage evaluation process and scoring methodology outlined in Section 6: Evaluation Process and Contract Award, located on pages 21 through 23 of the RFP, EHSD will select and award the best proposal for each region.

3. The RFP calls for three (3) org charts – in addition to agency wide org chart and program org chart, what is the third? Please clarify 3 charts.

Per Revised Section 8: Proposal Checklist, the number of Organizational Charts is not specified.

4. Could you please expound on the Attachments section of the checklist? We would like to know more of what you are asking for as it pertains to Monitoring/Performance Report or Letter of Recommendation. What specific elements are you looking for if Monitoring/Performance Reports are submitted? For a Letter of recommendation, what parameters are required for any agencies that could provide such correspondence (i.e.,

length of relationship, information regarding specific program partnerships, service delivery, etc.)?

Per revised Section 5.4.3.2 Agency Qualifications and Experience, "Attach a monitoring/performance report, or letter/statement of recommendation from a current funder/client regarding the Bidder's performance providing the services outlined under this RFP to validate Bidder's track record."

FISCAL

1. Is this FFPSA funding?

Per page 6 of RFP 1188, "Funding consists of State 2011 Realignment funds and County funds." Funding does not consist of Families First Prevention Services Act funds.

2. Is there a COLA anticipated after each year?

A Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) is not anticipated at this time. Cost of Living Adjustments are determined on a yearly basis.
