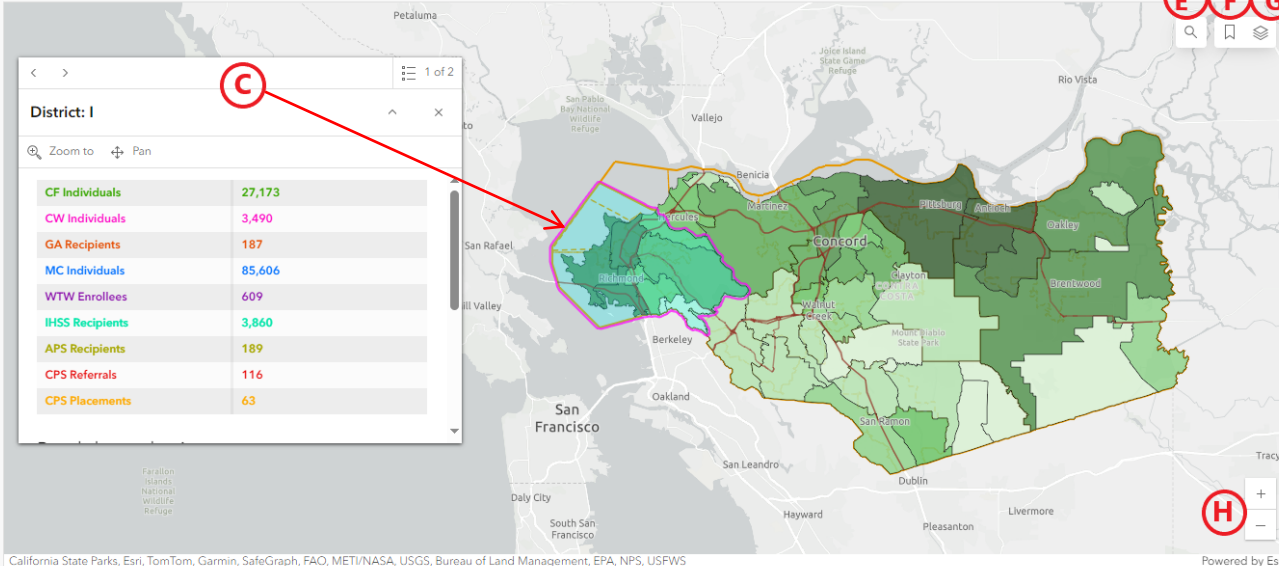

<b>B</b>	<b>Program Counts:</b> The total count for the area visible on the map; updates dynamically with Zoom In (+) & Out (-)	<b>E</b>	<b>Search:</b> Use the icon to find address or location (like city, hospital, school, etc.) on the map	<b>H</b>	<b>Zoom In (+) or Out (-):</b> Resizes the map. The map blanks out after a few Zoom In clicks to protect client information
<b>C</b>	<b>Popups:</b> Click anywhere on the map within the county/district to display the Program counts along with Age and Race/Ethnicity statistics.	<b>F</b>	<b>Bookmarks:</b> Use the ‘Home’ icon to return to the default map (whole county view).	<b>I</b>	<b>Legend:</b> Displays Program count range of the colors for selected layers. Transit layers with BART Map, Major Roadways and EHSD locations
