Student Intern On-The-Job Opportunities!

The Contra Costa County Community Services Bureau is offering a work experience program for low-income residents in our offices or child care centers to gain experience in the administrative and clerical field.

Participants will receive on-the-job training and are required to complete Metrix Learning online courses to remain in the program. Participants will also receive mentorship, including customer service and general office support skills.

- Participants are eligible to participate if they are low-income defined as at or below 200% of the federal poverty guideline and may be enrolled in school.
- Participants will receive \$21.06 per hour 18-20 hours per week.
 (Hours subject to change based on funding)
- Participants must successfully pass physical exam, tuberculosis and fingerprint clearances
- High school diploma, G.E.D. equivalency or high school proficiency certificate are required
- Must be 18 years of age or older.
